## About SWIN

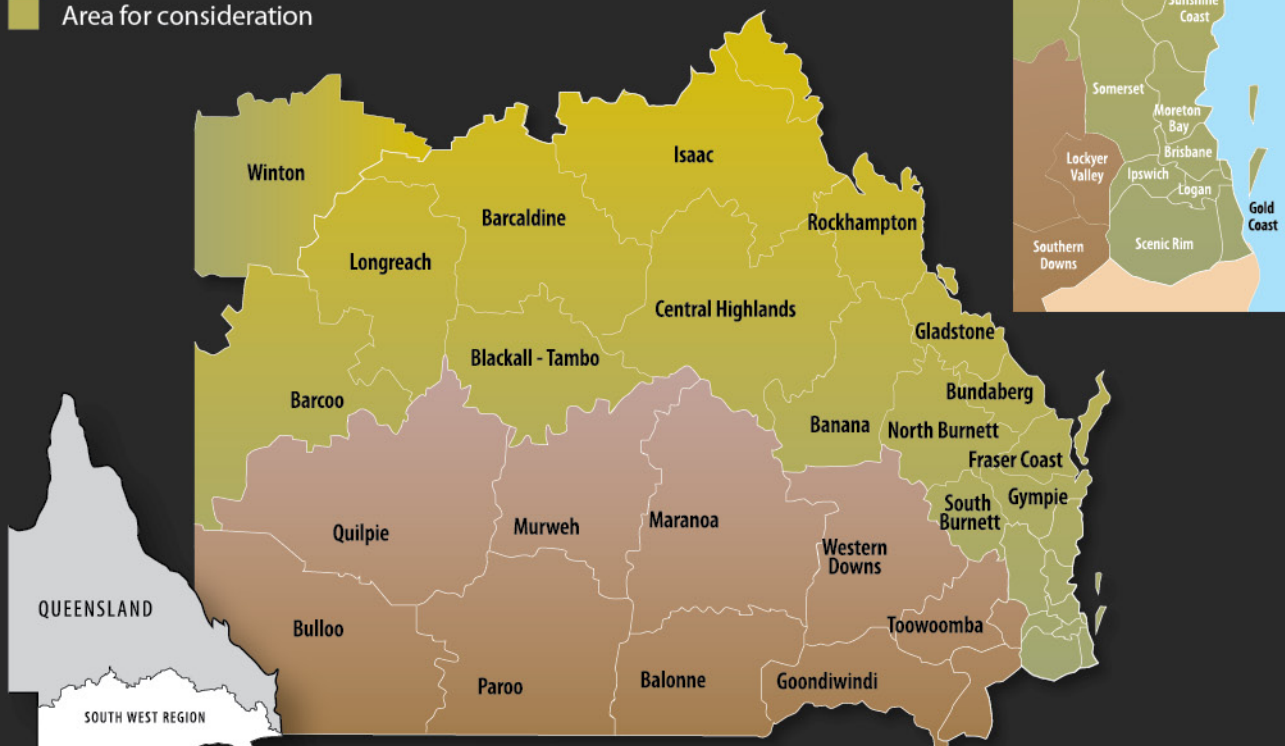
