Promote cricket throughout Indigenous communities as a sport, and as a fun loving and healthy outdoor activity for both males and females to participate in.



QUEENSLAND CRICKET

The concept was developed through consultation with SWIN and Queensland Cricket on delivering a participation initiative / carnival for Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islanders in the South West region of the State. This will provide an alternative style carnival to the ever-popular Rugby League, Touch Football and Golf participation days the region currently hosts.

The SWIN Committee and Queensland Cricket Development Staff declared "Western Rivers Cup" as the Carnival name to acknowledge the cultural significance of river systems to Aboriginal or Torres strait Islander people.

Team names are determined by the names of rivers such as Balonne, Maranoa and Paroo. The Western Rivers Cup Carnival has grown from 6 teams competing in 2013 for the Inaugural Cup, to 10 men's teams and 7 women's teams competing in 2021. We have no doubt the 2022 Western River's Cup will be bigger and better!

The Western Rivers Cup is endorsed by Queensland Cricket.

TEAM CRITERIA

- Players must be aged 16 years or older at the time of the Western Rivers Carnival.
- 2. Players cannot play in more than one team.
- **3.** Each team must have a minimum of 8 players, and maximum of 12 players. There must be at least 75% Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander players in each team.
- **4.** The organising committee must approve all non-Indigenous player's eligibility and availability.

For example: 4 current Imparja players equals team maximum of 20 points.

TEAM POINT SYSTEM

Each team will have a maximum allocation of 20 points. The following allocation applies:

REPRESENTATIVE EXPERIENCE	ALLOCATED POINTS
Non-representative Cricket	0 points
Played Imparja Cup over 5 years ago	2.5 points
Played for QLD over 5 years ago (Indoor or Outdoor)	5 points
Played Imparja Cup in the past 5 years	5 points
Played for AUS over 5 years ago (Indoor or Outdoor)	7.5 points
Played for QLD in the past 5 years (Indoor or Outdoor)	10 points
Played for AUS in the past 5 years (Indoor or Outdoor)	15 points
