

COMPETITION RULES

1. All 8 players must bowl one over (6 balls) each
2. Wide balls and no balls are each worth 2 runs
3. No free hits for no balls
4. There will be a maximum of 8 balls in an over for overs 1 – 7
5. The 8th over will be bowled out (not limited to 8 balls)
6. All overs are bowled at one end
7. There are no fielding restrictions
8. There will be no LBW's
9. Batsman must retire at 30 and can come back if all other wickets are lost. If more than one batsman retires, they return in the order they retired
10. 50 metre boundaries will be used
11. Injured Player (unable to bowl) – over will be bowled by a player nominated by the batting team
12. The Laws of Cricket will be used except for any exclusions mentioned previously
13. All teams must have a non-player (Team Manager/Coordinator) sit with the scorer for the duration of each match – this is compulsory
14. All players competing must wear batting pads and gloves





FORMAT

Each team will play 5 round matches with points allocated for each match as set out below.

WIN: 2 points DRAW: 1 point LOSS: 0 points

Should teams finish on equal points, Net Run Rate will be applied to decide which team/s progress through to the semi-finals (*Run Rate For minus Run Rate Against = Net Run Rate*)

Please note: *it is important scorers record for all batsmen whether they are out, retired or not out.*

MATCH REFEREE

Kent Reimers (*K78 Coaching & Consultancy*) will be Match Referee, and any rule interpretations will be his decision and these decisions will be final.

OFFICIALS

Umpires will be employed from the Toowoomba Cricket Association to officiate on the day.

SPIRIT OF CRICKET

In the event that an Umpire rules a catch has been deliberately dropped, or not attempted 10 runs will be given to the batting team.

EQUIPMENT

Where possible, players are to bring their own cricket equipment, however a "kit bag" will be available on the day at each field.

FOOTWEAR

Cricket shoes / boots with spikes are preferred to prevent injury.

REGISTRATION AND INSURANCE

Players will be required to sign a registration form on the day to ensure their liability and player insurance is current. The South West Indigenous Network will cover all insurance costs.

Players who were not previously regular cricketers will be able to continue their cricket by being directed to a local club in their region. This information will be available from Queensland Cricket.

Cricket Australia strongly recommends that community associations take all practical steps to adopt the ICC directive and mandate that all junior and senior players wear British Standard 7928:2013 compliant helmets from 2019/20 season onwards when batting, wicket-keeping up to the stumps and fielding in close to the batter.
